NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS

TERRITORY WITHOUT MUNICIPAL ORGANIZATION

The District of Thunder Bay Social Services Administration Board (TBDSSAB) is seeking nominations from residents who are interested in representing the territory without municipal organization in the District of Thunder Bay. On October 25, 2010, one representative will be elected as a Board Member for a four year term.

The District of Thunder Bay is responsible for the administration of Ontario Works, Social Housing, and Child Care. As a Board Member of the TBDSSAB you will be responsible for providing strategic direction for the development of social programs in the District of Thunder Bay and overseeing a budget of approximately \$73 million. An overview of the TBDSSAB responsibilities, procedural by-laws, program descriptions, and the TBDSSAB Annual Report are available on our website at www.tbdssab.on.ca.

Qualifications of members elected to represent the Territory without Municipal Organization (TWOMO) are as follows.

A member shall be:

- ⇒ a Canadian citizen who is at least 18 years of age;
- ⇒ a permanent resident of the territory without municipal organization; or
- ⇒ an owner or tenant of property in the territory without municipal organization; or
- ⇒ the spouse or partner of an owner or tenant of property in the territory without municipal organization.

Nomination Papers will be available January 4, 2010, and can be obtained from the 5th Floor, 34 N. Cumberland Street or www.tbdssab.on.ca. At the time of filing all candidates must pay a filing fee of \$100. This fee is refundable if after the official results have been determined they receive more than 2% of the votes cast in the election for the office. The nomination period will end at 2:00 p.m., September 10, 2010.
